Volunteer Release Form

1. I hereby release, discharge, indemnify, and hold Snake River Animal Shelter (SRAS) harmless for any and all personal property damage that occurs while volunteering at SRAS.
2. I recognize that I risk personal physical injury by handling animals at SRAS as a volunteer. On behalf of myself, my heirs, personal representative(s), and executor of my estate, I hereby release, discharge, indemnify, and hold harmless SRAS and its agents, servant, and employees from any and all claims, causes of actions or demands of any nature or cause connected with my volunteer activities and duties. This includes claims for costs and attorney fees. Such damages or injuries include, but are not limited to, animal bites or scratches, slipping or tripping accidents, allergic reactions, and personal property damage.
3. In case of emergency, I authorize SRAS to notify my emergency contact that I have listed on this form.
4. I understand that public relations are an important part of volunteering at SRAS. I, therefore agree to allow SRAS the perpetual use of any photographs or videos taken of me while volunteering at SRAS for use in public relations efforts in perpetuity. SRAS will use reasonable efforts to notify me prior to using my image or photograph, but such notification is not required unless the use is for some purpose other than public relations.
5. I hereby release SRAS from all liability for my refusal or failure to receive a tetanus vaccination prior to volunteering at SRAS. I understand that I refuse or fail to get vaccinated at my own risk. I recognize that Snake River Animal Shelter encourages all volunteers to be current on their tetanus vaccination before volunteering at SRAS. (If a volunteer has questions about the tetanus vaccination, he or she should consult a physician.)
